

Anzac Centenary South Australia Reflections Competition

TERMS AND CONDITIONS ON ENTRY

Category One – Short Film

Category Two – Photography

Category Three – Creative Writing (short story, poem)

Veterans SA will award an overall outstanding prize of a trip for two to the Australian War Memorial in Canberra, to the entrant judged to be the highest merit and best explores issues related to the Anzac Centenary Program. Each category will be awarded prizes as listed below:

Short Film - \$500 store voucher prize

Photography - \$500 store voucher prize

Creative Writing - \$250 store voucher prize (prose), \$250 store voucher prize (poetry)

One overall major prize of a trip to the Australian War Memorial in Canberra.
(Includes return flights from Adelaide, and two nights' accommodation)

1. This competition is conducted by the Anzac Centenary Coordination Unit, of Veterans SA, an agency of the Department of Treasury and Finance, located at Level 13, State Administration Building, 200 Victoria Square, Adelaide.
2. Information on how to enter and prizes can be found at www.anzaccentenary.sa.gov.au/competitions Entry into this competition is deemed acceptance of these Conditions of Entry. Entry is via Internet only.
3. On entering this competition, participants give Veterans SA the authority to promote them and use their entry details, if they are selected as the winner.
4. These conditions of entry govern the competition and are intended to be a legally binding agreement. Entry into this competition is deemed acceptance of these conditions of entry. For the purposes of Australian law, this competition is a 'game of skill' and chance plays no part in determining the winner.
5. Participation is open to any permanent resident of South Australia, over the age of 15. Participants under the age of 18 require permission from a parent or guardian to enter. If any prize winner is under the age of 18, the prize will be awarded to their parent or legal guardian on the winner's behalf.
6. Entrants can only enter in their own name. The winners must provide identification to Veterans SA within seventy two hours of being notified of winning in order to confirm the winners' identify, age, residential address, email address and eligibility to enter, before issuing a prize. If the documentation required by Veterans SA is not received, or the winning

entrant has not been verified or validated to the satisfaction of Veterans SA, the winner's entry will become invalid.

7. Prize values are those quoted at the time these terms and conditions were written and are subject to change. Prizes are not transferable or exchangeable. Veterans SA accepts no responsibility for any tax implications that may arise from the prize winnings. Veterans SA accepts no responsibility for any variation in prize value.
8. If any prize(s) become unavailable for any reason beyond Veterans SA control then a similar prize of equal or greater value will be awarded to the winner in lieu.
9. Entry is free and open to anyone who fulfils the entry criteria. The directors, management and employees (and their immediate family) for the Promoter (Veterans SA) are ineligible to enter the competition.
10. The use of any automated entry software or any other mechanical or electronic means that allows an entrant to automatically enter repeatedly is prohibited and will render all entries submitted by that entrant invalid.
11. The competition is not open to entries of work authored or produced by individuals who are deceased at the time of judging.
12. Eligible participants are invited to submit to the Anzac Competitions in the following categories; short film, photography, and creative writing (short story or poem.) Further information about the conditions of entry for each category can be found at www.anzaccentenary.sa.gov.au/competitions
13. The competitions commence Monday 11 September 2017 and conclude Saturday 11 November 2017.
14. To submit an entry, participants must complete the ONLINE ENTRY FORM and upload a copy of the digital file. Entries will not be accepted by post, hand delivery or email. Entries will not be returned.
15. Eligible participants may submit to a single category only.
16. Any contact details entered incorrectly on the website shall be deemed invalid and result in an ineligible entry.
17. Entries must be the original independent creation of the entrant and free of any claims, including copyright or trademark claims, by other parties.

Entries must not:

- a) have previously won and/or not be currently entered to win any other competition, prize or award;
 - b) infringe the rights of any other person including privacy, intellectual property rights (including confidential information) or moral rights.
18. Veterans SA reserves the right to verify the validity of entries and to disqualify any entrant from any category which, in the opinion of Veterans SA, includes objectionable content, profanity, and potentially insulting, inflammatory, libellous or defamatory statements. Veterans SA also reserves the right to

disqualify any entrant who, in the opinion of Veterans SA, engaged in conduct in entering the competition which is fraudulent, misleading, deceptive or generally damaging to the goodwill or reputation of this competition.

19. Entries received will be judged in the following categories by the following judging panel:
20. Judging will take place from Monday 13 November to Friday 24th November, 2017. The finalists will be notified on the week of Monday 27 November 2017. The winning entrant will receive their prize in February 2018, with the date yet to be confirmed).
21. All decisions of Veterans SA and the judging panel are final. Veterans SA and the judging panel will not enter into any discussions or correspondence regarding any decisions in relation to the final decision. No feedback will be provided on unsuccessful entries.
22. By submitting an application in all listed categories entrants are giving permission for Veterans SA to publish all works on the Anzac Centenary Website and associated social media channels to further promote the Anzac Centenary program.
23. The winner will be notified on a confidential basis by telephone prior to the public announcement of the prize winner. The winner must keep this confidential until the prize is announced.
24. The Winners of each category may be invited to participate in a media campaign as determined by Veterans SA, including but not limited to, being interviewed and photographed, filmed and having their name and photograph published in any publication at the discretion of Veterans SA.
25. Veterans SA accepts no responsibility for lost, late, incomplete, incorrectly submitted or misdirected entries.
26. All entrants are required to notify Veterans SA should their contact details change during the period of the competition.
27. No changes to the entry will be accepted after submission.
28. Entrants in each category (other than the winners) agree to grant Veterans SA a royalty-free, perpetual licence to use their submission to further promote the Anzac Centenary South Australia project, and for their entry to be included in the South Australian Time Capsule project.
29. The entrant's name, addresses, email addresses and telephone numbers, will be entered into a database to allow Veterans SA to send participants publications such as the weekly Think Piece Series and monthly E-News.
